How could he, a regal mouse who loved Christmas as much as anyone, forget such an important thing? What a sad state of affairs. And it was a sad state of affairs, but what grieved Brother Mouse most, what smote him hardest about a fading memory, was that he had even misplaced his very own name.

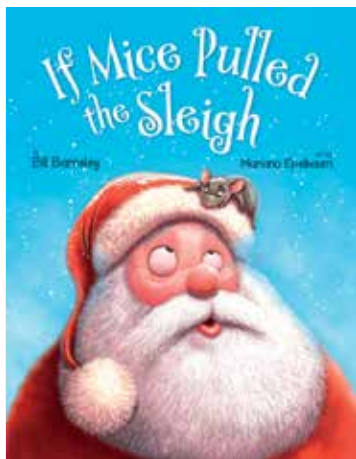

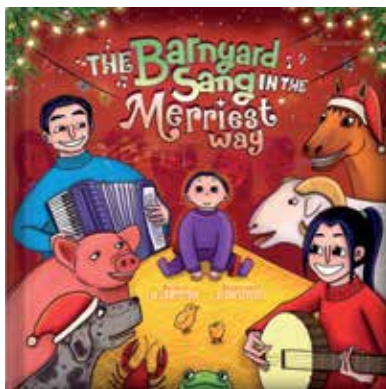


If Mice Pulled The Sleigh
